<b>Beacon of Hope</b>	\$22,700	Jefferson	Purchase of equipment to support telehealth services as well as infrastructural costs of expanding telehealth services while establishing new billing procedures.
<b>Clallam County Health and Human Services</b>	\$45,000	Clallam	Additional capacity to process COVID-19 tests and outreach to the most vulnerable populations in Clallam County.
<b>Discovery Behavioral Health</b>	\$20,000	Jefferson	Expanded ability to offer services to under/uninsured and Medicare clients. Wrap around services including food deliveries, etc.
<b>First Step</b>	\$20,000	Clallam	Expanded ability to connect clients to services virtually as well as outreach to vulnerable populations and those living in the West End of Clallam County.
<b>Hoh Tribe</b>	\$20,000	Jefferson	Establish safe space for members to utilize internet and equipment to access telehealth services.
<b>Jamestown S'Klallam Tribe</b>	\$20,000	Clallam	Ensure continued access to emergency pediatric dental care.
<b>Jefferson County Public Health</b>	\$40,000	Jefferson	Outreach and communications to students who receive services at school-based health clinics and the purchase of equipment necessary to continue in-person services at clinic sites.
<b>Jefferson Healthcare</b>	\$20,000	Jefferson	The purchase of necessary equipment to expand telehealth in outpatient primary care, specialty care, and inpatient.
<b>Kitsap Mental Health Services</b>	\$25,000	Kitsap	Purchase of equipment to provide more efficient telehealth services.
<b>Makah Tribe</b>	\$25,000	Clallam	Creation and distribution of home care and oral hygiene kits as well as purchase of supplies for medical staff.
<b>Olympic Peninsula Healthy Communities Coalition</b>	\$15,000	Clallam	Operational costs of the newly established Clallam County Helpline.
<b>Peninsula Community Health Services</b>	\$50,000	Kitsap	Continued operations of expanded mobile services to ensure access to preventative care.
<b>Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe</b>	\$40,000	Kitsap	Streamlined telehealth services across the spectrum of care.
<b>Quileute Tribe</b>	\$25,000	Clallam	The creation and distribution of wellness kits for isolated community members.
<b>Suquamish Tribe</b>	\$40,000	Kitsap	Adaptations to offices to allow for safe re-opening of services as well as culturally appropriate relapse prevention supplies and materials.
<b>West Sound Treatment Center</b>	\$15,000	Kitsap	Costs of continued telehealth services and contactless urine analysis to support Kitsap County Drug Court activities.
<b>YMCA</b>	\$15,000	Kitsap	Staff time to provide virtual general health and wellness checks for seniors in Kitsap County.
