The purpose of the value-based purchasing action group is to identify challenges, gaps, as well as advocate for creative solutions to expand and improve value-based purchasing efforts across Clallam, Jefferson, and Kitsap counties. Ultimately, the value-based purchasing action group will establish and present a set of recommendations to the OCH Board of Directors and Health Care Authority that meet the unique needs of the Olympic region.

Members

- To the best of our ability membership will comprise of representatives from Clallam, Jefferson, and Kitsap counties, managed care organizations, and a variety of sectors including hospital, primary care, mental health, substance use disorder treatment, and community-based organizations.
- Members should have backgrounds in contracting, value-based purchasing, and/or executive leadership.
- Members will comprise of both OCH Board of Director members and non.

Member responsibilities

- Review notes from previous value-based purchasing convenings and applicable Olympic region
 data.
- Actively participate in at least 75% of scheduled meetings
- Bring resources, tools, and learnings back to individual organizations and networks
- Identify and prioritize gaps and challenges specific to the Olympic region and various sectors
- Establish and present a set of recommendations and solutions to the OCH Board of Directors and Health Care Authority

- Foster a welcoming environment for all
- Clearly track and communicate desired outcomes, progress, and next steps at and in-between meetings
- Bring resources, tools, and learnings to support identified priorities

- Embed opportunities for fun
